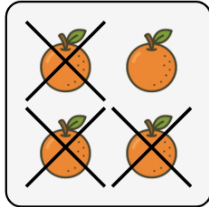

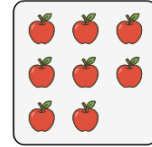
How many oranges are left?

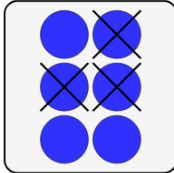


Remove 1 apple

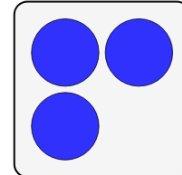

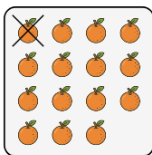

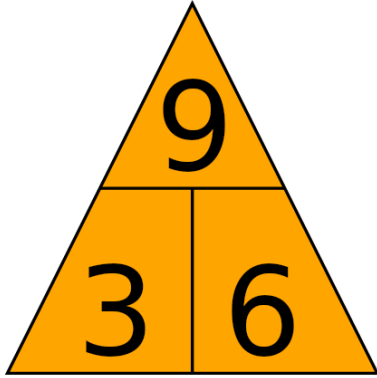

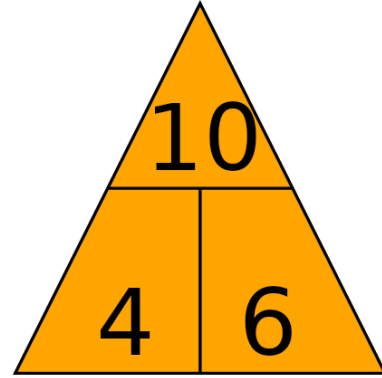
